Entry Fees: **\$2 per competitor per item**

Clubs should pay their entry fees as per the number of pupils registered on 31 March, \$2 per person, per item. The balance for extra pupils registered after that date should be paid within the seven days following the completion of our competition – an invoice will be supplied. A penalty of \$100 will apply to any Clubs who do not pay the balance of entry fees by the due date on your entry form.

Lighting and DLP

Lighting and DLP will be available for all allowable sections.
\$20 tech fee is payable for every AGE GROUP entered (except Tinies – see below), and this will INCLUDE the use of any DLP's. No further charges will apply.
This year Tinies sections will be exempt from any tech fee but will still have full use of lighting and DLP without charge, where item rules permit.

Conditions of Entry:

- A:** Coaches must be a registered, financial Level One/Two Coach with VCCA at the time of lodging entry.
B: Failure to notify a Competition Committee Secretary on 0425 796 259 at least 24 hours in advance of a nonappearance will incur a fine of \$100. Non-payment of this fine will automatically exclude the club from any competition for the following year. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED

Competition Rules

Coaches

NO SMOKING ANYWHERE ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS. This is a Federal Law and competitors and spectators may be asked to leave the premises if found to be breaking this law. Please make your older competitors aware of the consequences.

- **Coaches are responsible for**
 - (a) Maintaining **acceptable** behaviour of competitors.
 - (b) **Any** breach of Theatre rules, including practising in Foyer,
- **Passage ways must be kept clear at all times.** This is a theatre safety rule.
- **No practising in the foyer. Competitors must be appropriately dressed when practising outside.**
- **Please inform parents and others spectators associated with your club that the use of electronic devices, including phones, games and cameras may result in them being asked to leave the theatre.**
- Please ensure that **all** competitors **have been collected before leaving venue.**

Lighting

The following lighting is available for all teams:

9 spots, Centre Special, Curtain Special, Decal, Blinders, Mirror Ball, Upstage, Downstage, Cyc and stage colours – Blue, Red, Yellow, Green and combinations of these colours. Chases – Cyc, Stage and spot.

DLP - USB with DLP need to be handed to the supervisor when booking in so they can be loaded to avoid delays.

Late DLP's will not be accepted.

Running music through the DLP is NOT recommended and NO responsibility will be taken for technical faults that may occur as a result of non-compliance.
