Introduction

Calisthenics Victoria Inc. (CVI) is committed to high standards of ethical conduct and accordingly places great importance on making clear any existing or potential conflict of interest.

Purpose

This policy has been developed to provide a framework for all stakeholders in declaring conflicts of interest.

This policy states the approach taken by Calisthenics Victoria Incorporated (CVI) and its stakeholders to identify and manage conflicts of interests.

Stakeholders include the Board, Clubs, CVI Committees and associated committees and associations, the members of those committees and associations and CVI staff.

Policy

CVI and its stakeholders will use all reasonable endeavours to identify all actual, apparent and potential conflicts between its interests and those of its stakeholders. All such conflicts of interest shall be declared by the member concerned and documented in the Conflicts of Interest Register.

Any member who perceives that another member has an undeclared conflict of interest should specify the basis of this potential conflict.

Where a member has a conflict of interest, as defined by statute, that member shall not initiate or take part in any discussion on that topic (either in the meeting or with other members before or after the meetings), unless expressly invited to do so by unanimous agreement by all other members present.

Where a member has a conflict of interest, as defined by statute, that member shall not vote on that matter.
