BACKSTAGE

Arrival is 45 minutes prior to the start of the section. This includes time for warm up for free exercises. Please do not arrive earlier as we need to maintain separation of sections for contact tracing purposes.

As per Government requirements there will be a separation of backstage and audience members, including at drop-off & pickup times.

Clubs will be allocated a specific number of backstage passes (listed on the schedule next to number of performers). Only these people can go backstage at any time. Backstage lists must be up to date for COVID-19 contact tracing.

Teams will also be allocated dressing rooms with many teams split across multiple dressing rooms. This is to accommodate density limits in each room backstage.

Masks must be worn by coaches, assistants and performers aged 12 and over at all times except when fully exerting self or when on stage. Please ensure performers bring a zip lock bag side stage to leave mask in while on stage.

Music must be on a USB in mp3 format. Please ensure files are clearly labelled.

PRESENTATIONS

Aggregates will be announced on stage with coaches able to stand side stage during this period. Unfortunately, due to density restrictions and backstage separation requirements, performers must remain in dressing rooms during this time.

Teams must leave the venue quickly after presentations so please ensure bags are packed prior to the presentation. Crits will be collected backstage.

AUDIENCE

All audience members must scan a QR code upon arrival and masks must be worn by all audience members aged 12 and over unless an exemption applies.

Each club will be allocated a limited number of tickets based on team numbers and invoiced at a later date. Tickets will not be made available to the public due to the audience cap of 100. Ticket prices: Adult \$15, VCCA Member/Concession/Child \$10.

As per Government requirements there will be a separation of backstage and audience members, including at drop-off & pickup times.
